



## Series Norma





In this first step you will need the top cover (5), the bottom plate (10) and 2 x frame (6). Put the two parts of frame ready to assemble this part like picture with 16 x bolt M8\*12 (C) and 16 x flange nut M8 (D);



With the cable entry panel (11) and with the castors (12), assemble in the bottom plate with 24 x bolt M5\*10 (A);








This installation step is optional


This installation step is optional. With 24 x bolt M6\*12 (B)fix the mounting spacer to the mounting angle;

With the cabinet in the vertical, assemble the mounting angle (4) with 24 x bolt M6\*12 (B) in the horizontal sides of the cabinet;







Grab the 19" rails in the vertical and mount with 24 x bolt M6\*12 (B);



With 12 x bolt M5\*10 (A) fix the cable management (7) to the mounting spacer;



Now assemble the front door **(1)** and the rear door **(7)** you choose;

With  $2 \times 10^{10}$  (A) fix the accessory to the frame;



Put the side panels (2) and...

You are ready to go!

**Cautions** – To avoid any damage please ensure that is adequate space between each unit for good airflow. Take care to not exceed the 40°C – 104°F temperature.
